Principal Report – Michele Radke

Thank you to the support of the PTO and parents. The staff is very appreciative of the gifts and support that they are receiving. Kind words of support from the families are very appreciated. iReady testing is taking place this week. Kindergarten registration is open. Please share with friends and neighbors that have kids entering school next year. We will be rescheduling MaT Pajama and Kona Ice days when we have a better idea of timing. Spirit week is next week (12/14 – 14/17). More information to come from teachers this week. Elementary school is scheduled to restart in person learning on January 5th. The school board is meeting this Thursday and will update parents. The board continues to monitor the rise in cases and staffing. Hybrid is not being looked at as an option. Fifth grade will have Mrs. Williams back in January and staff is working on class rosters. Emails will be sent out next week to inform parents of any class changes. For those who will have Mrs. Williams moving forward, there will be a call set-up for introductions. Quarantine timelines have not changed. Douglas County is still 14 days and we continue to follow the Tri-County protocols. Daily school schedules are made at the school level. It is difficult with families with multiple kids to juggle lunch and recess. It would be much harder to manage if they were standardized across the school, especially delivering special needs support. Specials are difficult to do remotely. Please do your best with your kids and know that it is ok to be flexible. Communicate with the specials teachers if you adjust your child's schedule.

Thank you to everyone that helped get us to our Move-a-Thon goal of 20K. After fees, we will be right at our goal. 80% of students registered and 57% donated. 100 kids reached the popcorn and gift certificate goal. The extra Frosty coupons will be given to the staff to use before the end of the year. The last drawing for gift certificates will be done before the holiday break. The top earner in each class will be awarded soon and will be up to the teacher on what that will look like for their class. Chipotle Dine and Dash is December 7th. We will keep 33% of profits. The cookbook is scheduled to ship this week. Kelly will send out a note to those who ordered and coordinate pick-up before holiday break. The virtual book fair is happening now and we are still planning on holding a Read-a-Thon in February or March.
